RULES FOR ENTRY OF SHEEP IN THE FLOCK BOOK and APPENDIX A

Application for the registration of sheep not previously registered may be made by a member of the Society provided the following rules are observed:

- (a) Subscription for the current year has been paid
- (b) A Flock Prefix is Registered with the Society
- (c) The application for entry into the Register is accompanied by the current fees payable, as laid down in the Byelaws.
