Conditions of Entry & Rules

Jacob Sheep Society

1. All vendors must be fully paid up members of the Society.
2. All tags must comply with DEFRA / Scottish Government and Jacob Sheep Society regulations in force at the time of the sale. Sheep not correctly tagged (i.e. without UK and ID number / electronic tags for sheep born in or after 2010) may not be sold in **ANY** section of the sale.
3. A sheep may be substituted for an original entry provided that any substitution is by a sheep in the same class and that both the Auctioneer and the Society Secretary are advised not later than 7 days prior to the Show and Sale. Any substitute sheep must be identified with *RED SELLOTAPE* around its *RIGHT-HAND* horn.
4. All sheep entered for any Show and Sale must be onsite and **penned by 8.30am** on the day of the Show and Sale. Late arrivals will be excluded from the Show and Sale.
5. No sheep may be sold as registered at any Show and Sale unless the registration form for such sheep is lodged at the office of the Society Secretary at least **TWENTY-ONE** days before the relevant Show and Sale.
6. Appendix "A" and "B" ewes and lambs are NOT classified as "registered sheep" and may not be sold as such. Such sheep may be sold in the non-pedigree section of any sale.
7. All registered sheep entered and forward at any Show and Sale must be inspected to ensure their ear tag numbers tally with the catalogue and that they comply with the Society's breed standard. Should there be any slight faults with older sheep that the Inspectors wish to pass, the vendor will be informed and told that the Auctioneer will announce the fault before the sheep is sold. Should the vendor refuse permission for this announcement, the sheep will fail its inspection. The Inspectors' decision will be final.
8. Any sheep that fails the inspection referred to in 7 above shall be excluded from the Official Show and Sale but can still be offered for sale should the owner so wish but only at the conclusion of the Official Sale and PROVIDED THAT the Auctioneer announces before the sheep is sold that it has failed the Society's inspection and hence has not been included in the Official Show and Sale.
9. The vendor must lodge a Society Registration Certificate marked with the lot number with the Auctioneer for any registered sheep offered for sale.

10. No ewes will be accepted for any Show and Sale if they have been running with a ram.
11. Tay-Sachs - The Jacob Sheep Society runs a scheme whereby sheep are voluntarily tested for a Tay-Sachs marker gene by LGC Laboratories. Animals which have been DNA tested as Tay Sachs clear, have (TSC) added to their registration numbers. Animals with two (TSC) parents have the annotation (~) added to their registration numbers, indicating that they are 'bred Tay Sachs Clear.
12. Only rosettes that have been won on the day of the Show and Sale may be displayed at the sheep pens. **NO OTHER ROSETTES MAY BE DISPLAYED** although details of previous successes may be displayed.
13. No sheep shall be sold at a Show and Sale that has not been entered in the sale catalogue or in the Auctioneer's late entry list. No other sheep may be brought to any Show and Sale unless the Society Secretary and the Auctioneer has been notified and permission given.
14. **ALL SHEEP SOLD MUST BE SOLD IN THE SALE RING OR THROUGH THE AUCTIONEER'S OFFICE.**

1. All sheep will be sold in Guineas (£1.05) and in catalogue order. The Auctioneers to charge a commission of 5 pence in the Guinea. **In line with recent years, the JSS will waive its right to a levy at this sale.**
2. Cleansing facilities for vehicles and trailers will be available on site for a nominal charge.
3. It is the vendors and purchasers responsibility to ensure that all DEFRA / Scottish Government rules and regulations are adhered to with regard to movement of sheep at the time.
