Central Region Flock Competition & Assessment 2010

Friday 1st to Sunday 3rd October
Closing date Friday 24th September 2010

This year the Central Region Flock Competition will take place over the weekend of 1st/3rd October.

Our judges this year, Anna Milner and Bridget Wilson, are both experienced and well respected Jacob breeders and judges. They will be happy to discuss any problems you may be experiencing or the future development of your flock. There is no need to make any special preparation of your sheep for this competition but rams and ewe lambs will need to be penned so the judges can handle them. Ewes should be held in a confined area so that some of them can be handled if the judges wish but with the facility for them to be set free so that they can be seen moving naturally. Remember also that your routine management of the flock will be taken into account when judging as well as the uniformity and quality of the sheep.

Our aim is to make each visit friendly, informal and informative. If you have never entered before and are unsure whether to do so this time, please contact me or any member of the Regional Committee. We will be happy to answer any questions you may have.

Class 2	Large Flock	12+ Ewes	
Class 3	Group of ewe lambs	Minimum of 4 lambs – the judges will expect to see a presentation of approximately 20% of the flock size in larger flocks	
Class 4	a) Best 4 horn male	} One ram or ram lamb of any age is eligible for this class.	
	b) Best 2 horn male		

The **Anne Rowberry Salver** will be awarded for the best 4 horn flock; the **Dixon Trophy** for the best 2 horn flock; the **Central Region Tankards** for the best large and the best small flocks; the **Ridout Challenge Trophy** for the best flock overall; the **Bentley Trophy** for the best 4 horn male; the **Homelea Trophy** for the best 2 horn male and the **Nutwood Trophy** for the best group of ewe lambs.
