Parents should be aware that due to the nature of the hands on element of the evening it may not be appropriate for children under 12 to participate.

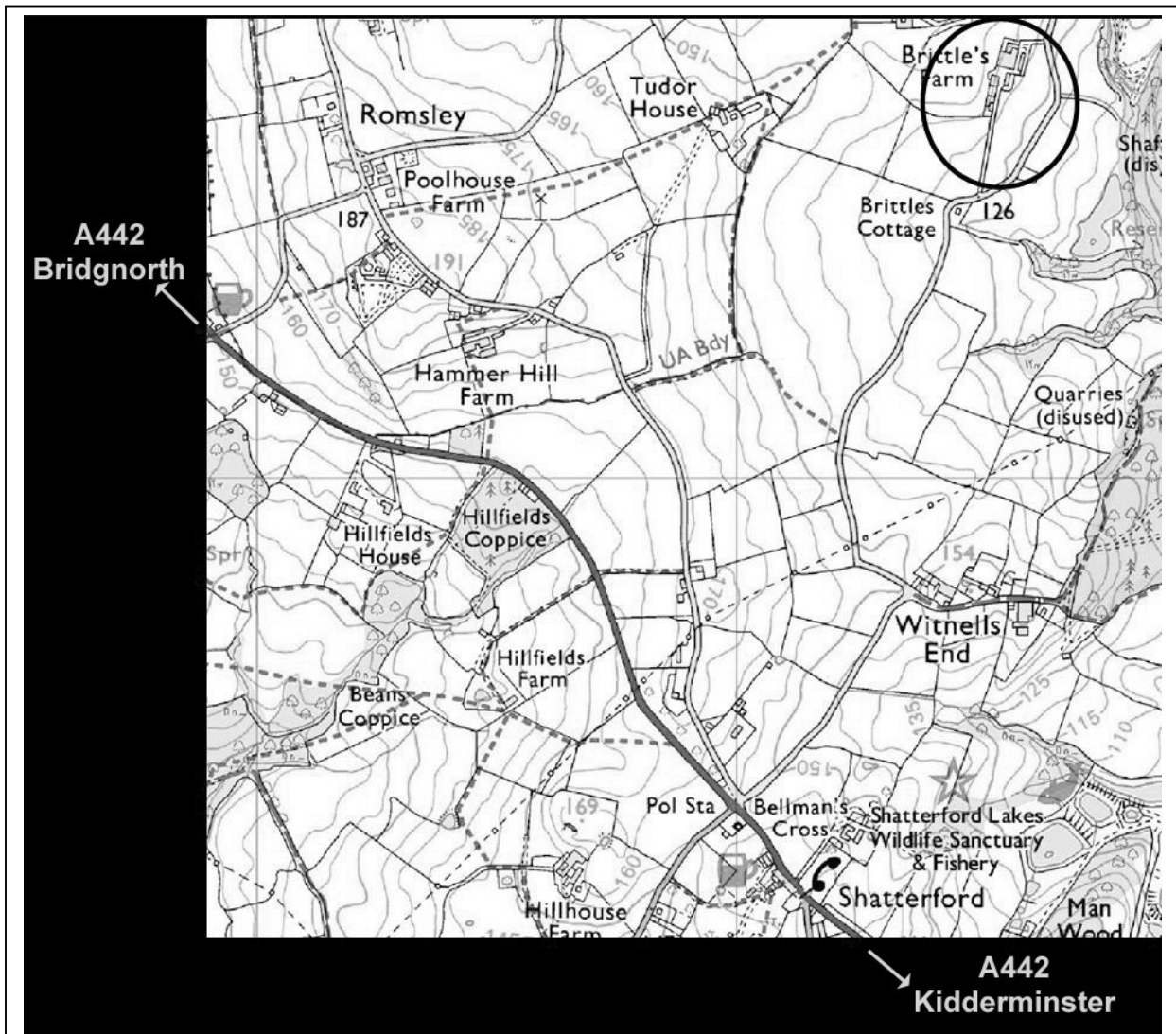
